5 Participants

- Implement the Oceanside Blvd Corridor Vision Statement.
- Align capital improvements with approved development and ensure that new development does not strain or overwhelm infrastructure capacity.
- Consider additional access across I-5, particularly for pedestrians and bicycles (e.g. Kelly Street).
- Improve maintenance and monitoring of the City-owned water tower property and consider implementing public amenities (e.g., park space) on underutilized portions of this property.
- Residents are split on the question of whether or not sidewalks should be implemented in Fire Mountain.
- Residents are split on promoting transit-oriented development within the Oceanside Blvd corridor.
- Consider establishing a habitat mitigation bank to facilitate restoration and long-term management of Loma Alta Creek.
- Consider additional upstream flood mitigation on Loma Alta Creek.
- The City's inclusionary housing standards are not producing much income restricted housing. Consider alternative means of incentivizing and/or requiring inclusionary housing in conjunction with market-rate housing development.
- Address potential traffic hazards at Yucca Road and Fire Mountain Road.
- Monitor traffic conditions at Grandview Street and Hunsaker Street, particularly in light of the recently approved housing project on the north side of Grandview.
- Consider a citizen steering committee to guidance on the implementation of the updated General Plan.
- Look for ways to enhance the pedestrian experience with landscaping, outdoor furniture, etc. in the right-of-way.
- Consider a road diet and roundabouts on Vista Way.



• Maintain the integrity of long-range plans and policies by applying them consistently and equitably, particularly in development review and CIP.
